

REGULAR MEETING

April 6, 2009

A regular meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Busti was held on April 6, 2009 at 6:45 p.m., at the Town Administration Building, 121 Chautauqua Avenue, Lakewood, New York with the following members present:

Supervisor Sullivan called the meeting to order with the salute to the flag and a moment of silence was observed.

Those present were: Angelo & Diane Terrano, Jessie Robbins, Colleen Orlando, Johneen Hoose, Daryl Ferraro, Loren Parker, Tim Young, Lakewood-Busti Police Chief John Bentley and Highway Superintendent Melvin J. Peterson.

Colleen Orlando appeared before the board regarding flooding on First Avenue in Cottage Park resulting with damage done to property owned by her at 2237 2nd Avenue. This was referred to Attorney Joel H. Seachrist for more information on the ownership of the drainage ditch on First Avenue.

Johneen Hoose and Busti-Lakewood Recreation Director Diana Peterson explained the Southwestern Swimming program to the board.

Loren Parker appeared before the board regarding tree and brush removal on the corner of 4th & 5th Avenues and Gleason Road. This was referred to Highway Superintendent Melvin Peterson.

Lakewood-Busti Police Chief John Bentley reported 838 incidents for the month of March with a total of 2,550 incidents to date.

Highway Superintendent Melvin J. Peterson noted the highway department will resume regular work days starting tomorrow.

Supervisor Sullivan offered the following motion which was duly seconded by Councilman Hajdu:

Councilman Hajdu reported the information he received on proposed revision to Ag District #12 for existing and proposed areas from County Cooperative Extension Office.
