

## REGULAR MEETING

December 5, 2011

A regular meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Busti was held on December 5, 2011 at 6:45 p.m., at the Town Administration Building, 121 Chautauqua Avenue, Lakewood, New York with the following members present:

Supervisor Sullivan called the meeting to order with the salute to the flag and a moment of silence was observed.

William Burk noted his desire to be appointed to the town board when a there is a vacancy.

Lakewood-Busti Police Chief John Bentley reported 589 incidents for November with year to total of 9,440.

Highway Superintendent Melvin J. Peterson reported that the highway department is on split shifts for the winter months.
