

REGULAR MEETING

August 20, 2012

A regular meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Busti was held on August 20, 2012 at 6:45 p.m., at the Town Administration Building, 121 Chautauqua Avenue, Lakewood, New York with the following members present:

Supervisor Robbins called the meeting to order with the salute to the flag and a moment of silence was observed.

Present at the meeting were: Angelo & Diane Terrano, Brett Muccheck, Lori Robbins, Loren & Gloria Parker, Alan Wallace, Randall Hinsdale, Attorney Joel H. Seachrist, Highway Superintendent Melvin J. Peterson and Busti-Lakewood Police Chief John Bentley. .

Randy Hinsdale appeared before the board requesting that certain roads be closed to traffic for the Busti Apple Festival on September 30, 2012.

Supervisor Robbins offered the following motion which was duly seconded by Councilman Thor:

RESOLVED, that the town authorize Highway Superintendent Melvin J. Peterson and Police Chief John Bentley to make whatever steps are necessary to secure proper traffic flow and safe passage for anyone attending the Busti Apple Festival;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Mill Road from the five corners of Busti to the bridge and then along Lawson Road to Busti Sugar Grove road be closed for the Busti Historical Apple Festival to be held on September 30, 2012 from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Busti-Lakewood Recreation Director Diana Peterson reported on a successful summer recreation program.

Supervisor Robbins thanked Superintendent Peterson for the highway department removing the tree that fell near the Gazebo last week in time for the chicken barbecue.

Busti-Lakewood Police Chief John Bentley reported 7,330 incidents to date.
