

REGULAR MEETING  
March 18, 2013

A regular meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Busti was held on March 18, 2013 at 6:45 p.m., at the Town Administration Building, 121 Chautauqua Avenue, Lakewood, New York with the following members present:

Supervisor Robbins called the meeting to order with the salute to the flag and a moment of silence was observed.

Present at the meeting were: Angelo & Diane Terrano, David Disalvo and Lakewood-Busti Police Chief John Bentley.

David Disalvo introduced himself and that he is running for trustee on the Village of Lakewood board on March 19, 2013.

Dog Control Officer Randy Erickson reported on dog control issues in the village and town.

Business Development Manager from Cobey Energy gave information on natural gas, vehicle performance and cost options for the town. Councilman Hanson will prepare a spread sheet on truck usage for Cobey Energy to review. The board thanked him for his presentation.
